REQUIREMENTS: Each team will prepare on site a minimum of 5 gallons of its special chili recipe. Your special condiments including chopped/diced ingredients can be brought prepared. The actual cooking of the chili will be done on site. We encourage all to prepare and cook more than the minimum. All cooking will be done on a portable gas stove or BBQ. Each team will be responsible for their stove, ingredients, and utensils (spatulas, frying pan and a minimum of a chili cooking pot). Electricity will not be available. Teams need to provide their own 10 X 10 popup, tables, chairs, gloves and a food thermometer (for health department requirements).

Teams must provide some sort of bowl or basin, water and towels for washing hands and utensils. The application and entry fee must be received no later than September 28, 2022 . Application can be mailed to Alpine Community Center, 1830 Alpine Blvd, Alpine CA 91901. Spaces are limited so please apply early. Contestants agree that any photograph of teams and /or cooking areas may be used for future promotional purposes. Tasting cups and spoons for sampling will be provided by the event.

Time Schedule: Set-up and cooking will start at 7:30 a.m. The event opens to the public at 12:00 noon. Judging will be done at 2:30 p.m. Award presentations will be held at 2:45 p.m.

Each team will be allowed to decorate their table and immediate area behind their tables as they see fit. This is a community fundraising event and is family oriented, thus decorations and costumes must be non-political and consistent with family views in mind. The organizers of the Chili Cook-off reserve the right to remove items that may endanger patrons or may be deemed offensive.

Contestants are not allowed to sell any food or items including their chili. Contestants compete solely for a plaque award and cash prize of First Place (\$200), Second Place (\$100) and Third Place (\$50) for "Best Chili". In addition, a trophy will be given out for "Best Decorated Booth". The public will pay a fee to the organizers for privilege of tasting a contestant's chili and to participate in the voting

PROCEEDS BENEFIT: This is an all-volunteer event and the proceeds after cost will go towards supporting the Alpine Community Center, a non-profit organization. Your support will go a long way. Step up to the challenge and create your favorite chili.
